**SATURDAY** – We leave Bretonside at 8am making a comfort stop at Sanders Garden World before heading straight for Central London. **SUNDAY** – This morning we will head out to Wimbledon for our behind the scenes tour of the grounds, including No. 1 Court, Henman Hill (or Murray Mound nowadays), the Press Interview Room, BBC Television Studio and admission to the museum. *The tour of the museum is fully accessible, however, the tour of the grounds, which takes about 90 minutes, involves a lot of steps which some may find challenging.* We then make an afternoon visit to Windsor for lunch, shopping or possibly a spot of sightseeing. We will depart Windsor at 4pm aiming to arrive back in Plymouth around 9pm.
